PEOPLE HOSTING UKRAINIAN CITIZENS or UKRAINIAN CITIZENS ARRIVING IN SPOLETO

Should a Ukrainian citizen be **without an identity document**, the Ukrainian Embassy in Rome will issue provisional identity certificates.

Ukrainian passports are extended up to 5 years
and allow entry and stay in Italy
for a maximum of 90 days without visa.

After 90 days it is necessary to regularise one's position by presenting oneself at the Police Office (Questura).

In the case of minors under 16 years of age, the data will be entered in their parents' passports.

PUBLIC HEALTHCARE SWABS

within 48 hours of entering Italy

Ukrainian citizens are required to be swabbed for SARS-Cov-2 free of charge, if not done at the time of entering the country. This can be done, after booking through the email address servizi.sociali@comune.spoleto.pg.it

by going to the Drive Through in Via Manna
from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. from Monday to Saturday.

Alternatively, if you are unable to go to the via Manna facility, you can send a request for a molecular swab at home
to servizi.sociali@comune.spoleto.pg.it

Important:
during the 5 days following the swab,
self-surveillance is required,
with the obligation to wear an FFP2 mask



PUBLIC HEALTHCARE VACCINATIONS

for the persons arriving from Ukraine it is recommended
vaccination against SARS-COV-2/COVID-19
from the age of 5 years,
for all those who declare that they have not been vaccinated
or are not in possession of documentation proving vaccination.

routine age-appropriate vaccinations are required for admission to school, please refer to Dr SONIA GALLO sonia.gallo@uslumbria2.it



PUBLIC HEALTHCARE ACCESS TO HEALTH SERVICES

Ukrainian refugees

can access all health services with the STP code

(Straniero Temporaneamente Presente

Temporarily Present Foreigner)

while waiting for the health card to be issued.

In order to apply for the health card, the foreign citizen with passport must go to the Agenzia delle Entrate (via del Risorgimento 30, S. Nicolò area) to obtain a tax code.

In order to be assigned a general practitioner, it is necessary to go to Palazzina Micheli with the receipt of the Declaration of Hospitality form and a passport or equivalent document.

TRANSPORT

Ukrainian citizens and subjects coming from Ukraine who enter the national territory can travel free of charge to reach the first place of destination or reception, within a maximum period of 5 days from their entry by filling in the declaration to the subject in charge of verifying the travel document

To enrol the kids, they require:

a sports medical certificate;
 compliance with the anticovid protocols issued by the individual Federations;
 the necessary routine vaccinations according to age



CONTRIBUTION

By 30 September 2022, through the https://contributo-emergenzaucraina.protezionecivile.gov.it platform, Ukrainian citizens who have applied for a residence permit for temporary protection can apply for the subsistence contribution for themselves, their children and minors for whom they are legal guardians.

The contribution is granted in **monthly instalments of €300 for a maximum of three months**from the date shown on the receipt of the application for a residence permit for temporary protection.

The parent or legal guardian of a child under the age of 18 is also granted a supplement of €150 per month per child.

For example, an adult who has legal guardianship of a minor may receive a contribution of 450 euros per month.



CONTRIBUTION

The contribution is intended to provide initial economic support in Italy and is

 intended for those who have found independent accommodation, including with relatives, friends or host families (for at least 10 days per month).

It is not intended for accommodation in facilities provided by the State (Cas - Centres for extraordinary assistance, Sai - Reception and integration system, facilities for widespread reception, hotels provided by Regions and Autonomous Provinces).

 for legal guardians, the Italian court's ruling certifying their status with respect to the minor is required.



CONTRIBUTION

To apply, you need:

tax code (codice fiscale) issued in Italy a cell phone number an email

- go to the Intercultural Desk in Via Busetti 28 on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m, on Fridays from 3 to 6 p.m; a native speaker mediator will be present. FOR INFORMATION call 0743/218151 or e-mail spoleto@cidisonlus.org during opening hours.

As for the contribution withdrawal, the Ukrainian citizen will receive a text message from Poste Italiane.

From that moment it will be possible to collect the contribution in cash at any post office counter.
